# What's Happening?

(News and Information from Session)

The Transition Team continues to work diligently toward finding an interim pastor for our church. They are consulting with Presbytery to consider hiring a part-time "bridge" pastor to provide some consistency while they conduct their search. Session, along with members of the congregation, will soon be participating in a Mission Study in order to determine what God is calling Forest Presbyterian Church to do in the coming years.

FPC member, John Bates, has published a book of devotions entitled **Two Years of Daily Devotions Based on the Common Lectionary.** Several copies are available in the church office and it can also be purchased on Amazon for \$9.95. John teaches our Adult Sunday School class and will also be serving as our Commissioner to Presbytery over the next year. We are grateful to God for John's contributions.

Session has approved a change in the Sunday morning schedule effective September 8<sup>th</sup> (Rally Day). Church School will begin at **9am**, followed by fellowship in the Commons at 10am, and worship at 10:30.

Session will be reviewing and updating church policies regarding Youth Protection, Sexual Misconduct, Harassment, and Antiracism.

The Finance Team is in the beginning phase of developing a budget for 2025 and planning for this fall's Stewardship campaign.

Grant applications have been submitted to the Synod of the Mid Atlantic for replacement of our piano, and to the Presbytery of the Peaks to support our church's participation in **Rise Against Hunger** next spring.

Please continue to keep our congregation in your prayers during this time of transition.

### A Word From CE - Christian Education – More than Sunday morning!

Rally Day. What does that truly signify at Forest Presbyterian Church? Having to get the kids up early so that they can attend Sunday school? Getting yourself up early to start going to church after the Summer away? What about that word "rally"? The Merriam-Webster's Dictionary has several definitions for "rally":

#### verb

- 1. to come together again to renew an effort;
- 2. to join in a common cause;

#### noun

- 1. a mustering of scattered forces to renew an effort;
- 2. a mass meeting intended to arouse group enthusiasm.

For this year, Rally Day is defined as all of us enthusiastically coming together as we renew our desire to learn and grow as a family of Faith.

This year, the motto of Christian Education is "More than Sunday morning". Our Church school kicks this off by sharing a common curriculum across all ages. "Feasting on the Word" is a church-wide curriculum that follows the lectionary calendar. This means that everyone will be studying the same text each week which will also be the basis for the time with children and the sermon (when the lectionary is followed in the service). Conversations at home become a bit more interesting when children and youth can add in their comments to what is usually an "adult conversation". We are all learning together.

Twice a month on Sunday afternoons, **FYRE Youth Group meets**. This is open to **ALL** youth (not just church youth) from grades 6-12. FYRE (Forest Youth Reaching Everyone) is expected to have a new level of energy as our leaders Lindsay Bennett and Macy Andrews put their creative minds together to ramp up the new year!

As we move into the Fall, a Confirmation class will be conducted for 8th - 12th graders. More on this in the October newsletter!

Bible studies disappeared during COVID but we are past that time and ready to get running again. On Rally Day, be sure to check out the CE table and indicate the type of Bible Study you are interested in. We are all learning and growing our Faith everyday. Let's remember that Christian Education is "More than Sunday morning!"

### FPC and KROGER


#### **KROGER CARES REWARDS PROGRAM**
